# 1 ORGANIZING AUTHORITY



## 2 RULES

Racing will be governed by The RSS 2013-2016. If there is a conflict between Class Rules and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall apply.

# 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

Boats must meet the following requirements to be eligible to race:



Monohull or Multihull sailing vessel of 22' LOA or greater and with an ELI/PHRF rating of 300 or less.

(Note: there is be a minimum number of five completed entries for a multihull division.)

Entry will be FULLY COMPLETED if the following 3 items are received by the published deadlines.

- Entry fee: Payable On-line at <u>www.pbsa.us</u> or by Check (PBSA P.O. Box 1196, Cutchogue, NY 11935)
- 2. Fully Completed Entry Form: Submitted on-line at <a href="https://www.pbsa.us">www.pbsa.us</a> MAIL-IN ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- 3. A valid rating certificate from PHRF of ELI, or a completed Temporary Day Rating Application.

# **Entry Deadlines:**

Friday, September 4, 2015	Open on-line entry period for all boats ends.  On-line entries after this date must add \$50.00 late charge.  Enter On-line at: www.pbsa.us
Wednesday, September 23, 2015	Last day to order gear. On-line gear ordering ends.  There will be NO GEAR SALES at the Skippers meeting or Party, advance orders ONLY  Order On-line at: www.pbsa.us
Wednesday, September 23, 2015	Entry Dead line for registration and mailed entry payments.  Hand delivered entry forms will NOT be accepted.  Accordingly, you are strongly urged to submit your  COMPLETE application on-line in a timely manner.
Monday, September 28, 2015	Division Change Deadline Changes between Spinnaker division and Non-Spinnaker division will not be permitted after this date.

# 7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS/RACE PACKETS

Sailing Instructions will be posted at <a href="www.pbsa.us">www.pbsa.us</a> in early September. Race Packets will include a backstay division flag, sailing instructions and scratch sheet and will be available at the Friday night Pre-Race Party/Skipper's Meeting. Division flags must be flown from the backstay (preferably) or stern of competing sailing vessels. Participants are strongly encouraged to attend the Pre-Race Party/Skipper's Meeting or arrange for a fellow competitor to pick up their Race packet. Packets may be available Saturday morning on the water via support boat.

## 8 THE COURSE

The course for each Division will be selected by the Race Committee from the list of courses contained in the Sailing Instructions. All courses start in New Suffolk and may circumnavigate Shelter Island. Course lengths vary up to 30 miles. A shortened course may not circumnavigate Shelter Island.
